RULES AND REGULATIONS

I AIM AND PURPOSE

- a. The Surana & Surana International Law Moot has been conceived with the aim of creating opportunities for learning the development of jurisprudence on emerging trends in International Law besides developing cutting edge skills in research, writing and advocacy.
- b. Further, it is aimed to facilitate the evolution of International Law through the jurisprudential analysis of the existing law and consequential emergence of new laws.

II VENUE AND DATE

The 5th Surana & Surana & RGNUL International Law Moot Court Competition, 2022 shall be held from 29th September – 1st October, 2022 at Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab, Bhadson Road, Sidhuwal, Patiala-147001.

III LANGUAGE

The competition shall be in English language only.

IV ELIGIBILITY

The competition is open for students who are studying LLB three years or five years course during the current academic year interested in International Law.

V TEAM COMPOSITION

- a. Each team should consist of a minimum of 2 and maximum of 3 members. This number cannot be modified under any circumstances.
- b. There shall be 2 speakers and 1 researcher designated for each team. The researcher shall be allowed to argue with prior permission of National Administrator in case of illness of the designated speakers.

- c. Each team will **be provided a competition team code** during orientation. Teams should not disclose the identity of their institution; such disclosure shall invite penalties including disqualification. The decision for the same shall be at the discretion of the National Administrator.

VI REGISTRATION

- a. Online registrations are open from **August 4, 2022**. The teams must register online by **August 31, 2022**. Teams will have to register online at www.moot.in.
- b. *Only 24 teams will be registered to participate in the competition on the first- come- first serve basis.*
- c. Participants will receive an automated system generated acknowledgement on successful submission of registration. Participants will receive an approval as acceptance of their request for participation latest by 2nd or earlier.

d. Registration Process

Option 1 - The Registration form cum Approval letter as provided in the rules duly signed & sealed by your university / college / moot society.

Option 2 - Upload both (i) & (ii) as detailed below together **as a single PDF**. *Please note (ii) has an option*

- (i) The Registration form cum Approval letter (without seal & signature) as provided in the rules duly filled along with
- (ii) Scanned copy of authorization letter with sign and seal from your university / college / moot society

Or

An email communication from the official id (to be filled as notification email id during online registration process) of the institution, from your university / college / moot society to complete the registration process.

Note :

1. Signatories on the registration form should be any of the following :- Faculty- in-charge of MCA / MCS / MCC, Registrar, Dean, Principal, Director, Chancellor or Vice-Chancellor

2. Registration without the scanned copy of the approval letter / an email communication from the college/institution/university or duly attested registration form will not be valid.
 - e. Soft copy of the registration and approval letter/ an email communication as a **single PDF** to be sent by email to: mootcommittee@rgnul.ac.in marked as 5th SURANA & SURANA AND RGNUL INTERNATIONAL MOOT COURT COMPETITION REGISTRATION as subject of the mail latest by **1st September 2022**. **The provisional team code shall be allotted to the registered teams by Host University soon after receiving of registration particulars.**
 - f. On receiving the provisional team code from moot committee of RGNUL you may proceed to pay the registration fees.
 - g. **The registration fee of Rs. 6,000 is to be paid online by September 2nd . The participants can pay by accessing the link provided: <https://www.rgnulrp.org/lsa/eventPortal/loginFrom.jsp>. Receipt of the online payment is to be sent by email to: mootcommittee@rgnul.ac.in. Confirmation of the same will be mailed after receiving of the receipts.**

VII ORIENTATION

There will be an Orientation Program for all the participants on **29th September 2022** (Friday) followed by a draw of lots & exchange of memorials. **Competition Team codes and side** will be allotted during orientation only.

VIII ROUNDS

There will be two preliminary rounds of arguments, a quarter-final round, a semi-final round and a final round.

VIII.A. Preliminary Round

- a. There will be two preliminary rounds of arguments per team, once for applicant & another for respondent.
- b. No team will face each other more than once in the preliminary rounds.
- c. Each team will face a different bench in their second round of arguments.

- d. Preliminary /Quarter finals will be held on **30th September 2022 (Friday)**.
- e. Top Eight teams from the Preliminary Rounds will advance to the Quarter finals rounds that will be decided on:
 - i. Win points
 - ii. Win points + Aggregate raw points
 - iii. Win points + aggregate raw points (in case of tie minus memorial marks)

Memorial marks will be added to the scores of both the preliminary rounds only.

VIII.B. Quarterfinals / Semi-finals Round / Final Round:

- a. Lots / power matching will decide the side of the arguments in Quarterfinals, Semifinals & Finals.
- b. The Quarter Final Rounds will be held on **30th September 2022**.
- c. The Semi Final Rounds will be held on **1st October 2022**.
- d. The Finals will be held on **1st October 2022**.
- e. The Quarterfinals / Semi-finals will be a knockout rounds.

IX RESULTS

Results of the preliminary rounds shall be announced after the completion of rounds of all the teams. Similarly, the results of the Quarterfinals / Semifinals shall be announced after completion of the rounds of all qualified teams of respective rounds. The results of the final rounds shall be announced in Valedictory Ceremony.

X MEMORIALS

The following requirements for memorials must be strictly followed. Non-conformities will be penalised:

- a. Each team must prepare memorials for both parties to the dispute (Applicant and Respondent).

- b. One advance hard copy of the memorials (both Applicant & Respondent) must reach the host institution (Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab) for evaluation by **27 September 2022** latest by 5:00 p.m. No excuses in respect of delayed courier services will be entertained. The memorials should be sent to following postal address **through speed post only**:

- c. The Soft copy of the memorials from both sides in word format and pdf format (*.doc or *.docx and *.pdf) must be mailed to: mootcourt@lawindia.com and mootcommittee@rgnul.ac.in by **22th September 2022** latest by 5:00 p.m.
- d. Late submission of soft copy of the Memorials will be penalised by one point for every hour, maximum penalty not exceeding 20 points.
- e. Late submissions of Hard Copy of the Memorials will be penalized by one point each memorial for every day of delay after due date.
- f. The teams are requested to carry along 4 copies from each side of the Memorials with them and submit the same during orientation on Thursday **September 29, 2022**.
- g. Once the memorials have been submitted, **no** revisions, supplements, or additions will be allowed.
- h. The memorials have to be submitted on typed A4 size paper printed on one side and must contain:
- i. Table of Contents
- a) Index of Authorities
 - b) Statement of Jurisdiction (not more than 1 page)

- c) Statement of Facts (1 page only and argumentative statement of facts would attract penalties)
 - d) Statement of Issues (not more than 1 page)
 - e) Summary of Arguments (not more than 2 pages)
 - f) Arguments Advanced (not more than 15 pages)
 - g) Prayer (not more than 1 page)
- j. Uniform font style is to be followed throughout the Memorial. The Font Style should either be Times New Roman or Garamond. The font size of the text should be 12 points (doubles space) and the font size for footnotes should be 10 points (single space) with single space between two-foot notes.
- k. The memorials should be spiral / staple bound or stitched. Any other form of binding will attract penalty.
- l. The memorial must have a margin measuring one inch on all sides of each page.
- m. All the pages of the memorial, except the Cover Page shall be numbered. The page numbering should be on the top right corner of each page.
- n. Covers must be placed on briefs as follows:
Applicant: Blue Colour;
Respondent: Red Colour.
Use of Cellophane sheets over the covers or inside will be penalized
- o. The cover page of the memorial must state the following:
 - i. The cause titles
 - ii. Identify brief as Applicant & / Respondents as is applicable
 - iii. Provisional Team Codes (see, Rule VI (f)) on the top right corner of the Cover Page.
- p. The teams are advised not to reveal their personal identities or the identity of their institution anywhere in the memorials. Violation of this provision shall result in penalties including deduction of marks or disqualification from the Competition. The decision of the National Administrator shall be final in this regard.

XI ORAL ROUNDS

XI.A. Preliminary Rounds & Quarterfinals

- a. Each team will get a total of 30 minutes to present their case. This period of 30 minutes is inclusive of the time reserved for rebuttal and sur-rebuttal.
- b. The division of time is at the discretion of the team members, subject to a maximum of 15 minutes per speaker. It is the duty of the Team to inform the division of time to the court clerk before the arguments begin.
- c. Oral Pleadings shall be confined to the pleading in the Memorials.
- d. The Researcher can, through Court Clerks, pass notes to the Speakers during the Oral Pleading Round subject to the discretion of the Judges.
- e. The attendance of the Researcher at the time of Oral Pleading Rounds is compulsory.

XI.B. Semifinals & Finals

- a. Each team will get 45 minutes to present their case inclusive of the time reserved for rebuttal and sur-rebuttal.
- b. The division of time is at the discretion of the team members, with a maximum of 25 minutes and minimum of 20 minutes per speaker.
- c. Oral Pleadings shall be confined to the pleading in the Memorials.
- d. The attendance of the Researcher at the time of Oral Pleading Rounds is compulsory.

XII DRESS CODE

The dress code shall be advocate's attire during the competition rounds.

XIII SCOUTING

Teams will not be allowed to observe the orals pleading rounds of any other teams. Scouting is strictly prohibited. Scouting by any of the team members shall result in disqualification from the Competition.

XIV SCORING

XIV.A. Orals

The parameters for judging the oral presentation on a scale of 0 – 100 points are:

- i. Knowledge of facts
- ii. Logic and reasoning
- iii. Organisation and clarity
- iv. Persuasiveness
- v. Deference to the court
- vi. Proper and articulate analysis of the issues arising out of facts
- vii. Understanding of the legal principles directly applicable to the issues
- viii. Ability to explain clearly the legal principles in general keeping to the time allotted.
- ix. Knowledge and use of legal sources and authorities and general principles of International law.
- x. Ingenuity (ability to argue by analogy from related aspects of law)

XIV.B. Written Submissions (Memorials)

- a. The memorials shall be marked on a scale of 1-100 points each.
- b. Any revisions, supplements or additions to the memorials after submission shall attract severe penalties subject to the discretion of the National Administrator.8
- c. Award of the points shall be based on the following parameters:

- i. Logical progression of ideas
- ii. Effective use of headings to outline arguments
- iii. Understanding essential legal issues presented
- iv. Focus on essential (not collateral) issues
- v. Clear, concise and unambiguous writing style
- vi. Forceful and persuasive presentation
- vii. Integration of facts into legal argument
- viii. Understanding of strengths and weaknesses of case
- ix. Discussion of viable alternative arguments
- x. Understanding and analysis of authority
- xi. Proper use of citations and citation form
- xii. Effective use of authority to support arguments
- xiii. Ability to distinguish adverse cases.
- xiv. Neatness, legibility, no typographical errors, or format errors

d. non-compliance of the rules mentioned in Clause X above shall attract severe penalties.

XV AWARDS

- a. Winner – Rs. 21,000/-
- b. Runner's up – Rs.15,000/-
- c. Best Memorial - Rs. 8,000/-
- d. Best Student Advocate – Rs. 8,000/-

All participants will be issued participation certificates.

XVI ANONYMITY

- a. Student counsel may introduce her/himself to the court in the usual manner and may also state her/his names. However, the team's college / institution affiliation may not be mentioned at any time before the awards ceremony.
- b. Further, all team members, coaches, advisors, and observers shall refrain from identifying a team's school at any time and in any manner, including, but not limited to, wearing any identifying items, such as school clothing, ties, patches,

or pins or carrying identifying material (such as a book with a college logo, or college seal).

XVII FINALITY OF THE DECISION

The decision of the judge shall be final and binding.

XVIII COPYRIGHT

- a. The copyright over the memorials submitted for participation in the competition is assigned by participants and shall also vest completely and fully in Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab and Surana & Surana International Attorneys Chennai. The participants shall certify in writing the originality of materials contained therein and shall be responsible for any claim or dispute arising out of the further use and exhibition of these materials.
- b. Further use and exhibition of these materials, electronically or otherwise, shall be the exclusive right of Surana & Surana International Attorneys, Chennai and Rajiv Gandhi National University of Law, Punjab and they shall not be responsible for any liability to any person for any loss caused by errors or omissions in this collection of information, or for the accuracy, completeness, or adequacy of the information contained in these materials.
- c. Distribution of these materials on affiliated websites such as www.moot.in does not constitute consent to any use of this material for commercial redistribution either via the Internet or using some other form of hypertext distribution.
