







Official Rules for the Surana & Surana India (South & North) Rounds of STETSON INTERNATIONAL ENVIRONMENTAL LAW MOOT COURT COMPETITION – 2010-11

- 1. The rules are slightly modified for the India National Rounds
- 2. For the World Finals the Winners of India (North & South) Rounds are guided by the INTERNATIONAL RULES ONLY that may be downloaded from www.law.stetson.edu

- 3. The 2010 Stetson (India) will have India South & India North Rounds.
- 4. The competition will be held in two phases:

 $India\ South-12-14\ Nov\ 2010\ (Friday,\ Saturday\ \&\ Sunday)$

India North – 26 – 28 Nov 2010 (Friday, Saturday & Sunday)

(Day 1) Inauguration, registration, orientation and draw of lots

(Day 2) Preliminary rounds & Quarter Finals

(Day 3) Semi Finals (forenoon), Final (afternoon) followed by valediction and prize distribution

- 5. Every team will argue at least once for Applicant as well as Respondent in the preliminary rounds. The time limit is 30 mts per team for Preliminary & (quarters, if required) and 45 mts per team for Semi Finals and Final. The time covers oral arguments and rebuttals.
- 6. The teams will pick lots to choose the side they argue.

- 7. Each team can have two speakers and one researcher. Two additional members (total 5) may accompany the team, but will not participate in the proceedings. All members will be awarded participation certificates.

 Additional members will be given participation certificates only even if their teams win in any category.
- 8. IMPORTANT Strictly only <u>3 members</u> each from the winning and runner up teams will be eligible to participate in the International rounds. Teams that have upto 5 members in the India South / North rounds cannot claim the right to participate in the International rounds for the additional members. Teams are requested to mention clearly the name of the additional members in the registration form. Please read international rules and regulations carefully.
- 9. Teams are not allowed to use laptops / computers in the court room during the oral rounds
- 10. The Judges will not announce the results after each oral round.
- 11. The administrator(s) will announce the result shortly after the completion of all preliminary rounds. Results of the Semi Final rounds will be announced shortly after the rounds. The final results and the winners of different categories of prizes will be announced only during the prize distribution ceremony.
- 12. The rules concerning the memorials format and page / word limit are same as that of the International Rounds, which can be found in the rules and regulations available in the website www.law.stetson.edu
- 13. For convenience of exchange of memorials we stick to the rule of color.

 Applicant Light Blue paper cover; Respondent Light Red paper cover. Recycled paper is encouraged. Use of plastic / cellophane sheets in memorials will attract penalty
- 14. Six copies of memorials each (6 Applicant and 6 Respondent) + soft copy on a CD (both Applicant & Respondent memorial may be in the same CD) MUST be submitted during registration at the venue (Non submission will attract penalty).
- 15. Soft copy of both Applicant & Respondent memorials (only 2 complete files) is to be sent by email in MS Word format to mootcourt@lawindia.com. One advance hard copy of each (Applicant & Respondent) has to reach the Principal / Moot in-charge, of the host institution, latest by 5 November 2010 (for both rounds) for the purpose of evaluation. Late submissions will attract penalty of 1 point per memorial for each day of delay.
- 16. For Best Student Advocate award the points scored from the preliminary rounds alone will be counted
- 17. Memorial scores will be added to the individual oral scores during the preliminary rounds for declaring the winners. Memorial scores will not be added at the knockout stage. (Quarter Final, Semi Final & Final)
- 18. The Winner and Runner-up team of India South & North (total 4 teams) will represent India in the World finals on March 17 20, 2011, at University of Maryland School of Law, Maryland

- 20. The organizers would provide accommodation and food for only 3 participants per team during the competition.

 Additional members if any, must make their own arrangements. Accommodation details (with address phone nos.) after finalisation will be posted on the website www.mootsite.com. Contact details of moot incharge and volunteers incharge will be provided in this website once it is finalised.
- 21. In addition Surana & Surana will reimburse sleeper class, Non A/c train fare (to & fro) to participating team members (maximum three members) from remote areas of India. Teams desirous of claiming reimbursement must write / email to the organizers in advance through their respective institutions.
- 22. The Administrators' decision shall be final in all matters concerning the competition.
